Temporary Closure Scheduled for Rancho Los Alamitos Easter Sunday, April 24 through Tuesday, June 14, 2011

Long Beach, CA - Notice of Closure to the Public - Easter Sunday, April 24 through Tuesday, June 14, 2011. Staff has worked hard to keep the site open to the public during the entire restoration of the Historic Barns Area and the construction of the new, state-of-the-art Education Center. However, the Rancho must close for about one month in order to demolish and then repave the parking lot and main driveway. This will enable installation and connection of new utilities for the Education Center and integrate them into the overall site utility distribution.

Except for already scheduled school tours and children's Native American Cultural Workshops, the site will close to the public from Easter Sunday, April 24th through Tuesday, June 14th. Luncheons and special tours already scheduled during this timeframe will be accommodated. The understanding and cooperation of visitors is appreciated. A visit to the Rancho is a retreat from the bustle of the surrounding city. The site is normally open for tours Wednesday through Sunday from 1-5 p.m. School tours and Children's Native American Cultural Workshops are scheduled weekday mornings. Admission is free and free parking is available on site. Enter though Bixby Hill residential security gate at Anaheim and Palo Verde.

Rancho Los Alamitos is owned by the City of Long Beach and operated by Rancho Los Alamitos Foundation as a public/private cooperative venture under the auspices of the Department of Parks, Recreation and Marine.
