How to create your own CARDBOARD COW:


- 1. A cow's skin is called its hide. Color your cow's hide, horns, and snout, and then cut them out.
- 2. Glue the paper "hide" around the cardboard roll.
- 3. Glue the horns and snout to the roll.
- Add googly eyes above the snout. You might need an adult to help you peel the back off the googly eyes.
- 5. Cut some yarn and glue it in the center of the horns above the eyes.
- 6. Punch or cut a small space at the bottom of the roll in the front and back. Color a rectangle on each side of the space to create the cow's hooves.


